

Expert Panel Discussion & Your Questions Proposal 5: A proposed pro-abortion amendment to the Vermont Constitution.

*Article 22. Personal Reproductive Liberty

*That an individual's right **to personal reproductive autonomy** is central to the liberty and dignity to determine one's own life course and shall not be denied or infringed unless justified by a compelling State interest achieved by the least restrictive means.

Proposal 5 was passed by both the House and Senate during the 2019 legislative session. The measure will need to pass both the House and Senate again in the next biennium.

If Proposal 5 passes the Legislature in the 2021—2022 session, the language above will be placed before the voters of Vermont on the general election ballot of November 2022.
